No exemptions, no-loss determinations, or replacement plan reviews were requested. The Gaylord Field office received over 500 drainage requests in 2011; the majority were maintenance requests, or for new drainage in areas that were not deemed wetlands. The "Swampbuster" provisions of the 1985 farm bill still hold sway in protecting the majority of the existing wetlands in the County, including those which may be exempted by WCA.
