Actual Results	Project proposals reviewed in 2012 involved maintenance and improvement proposals for public and private drainage systems; a proposal for a recreational trail; and two projects involving road and ditch maintenance adjoining Department of Natural Resources Wildlife Management Areas. Sibley SWCD completed its cooperative agreement with the Natural Resources Conservation Service to assist them in level one wetland determinations (slide reviews). The Gaylord Field office again received over 500 drainage requests in 2012, the majority being maintenance requests of existing drainage systems, and for new drainage in areas that were not deemed wetlands. "Swampbuster" provisions of the 1985 farm bill still hold sway in protecting the majority of the existing wetlands in the County, including those which may be exempted by WCA. Actual Results	Inspected 3 feedlots in shoreland. We will continue to be involved with Rush River and High Island Watersheds and the Lake Titlow and High Island Lake projects. Working together with the DNR, Watershed Coordinator and lake clean up groups. Ongoing inquiries within the Shoreland District as well as working together with the DNR hydrologists on shoreland issues. Sibley County Board of Commissioners voted to proceed with Redetermination of Ditch Benefits on 5 ditches in 2009. In late 2010, the County Board authorized the 2nd phase of Redetermination on an additional 5 ditches. This involves the seeding of the 1 rod grass buffer strip on each side of the ditches. In 2013, Phase 3 of the Redetermination of Benefit will begin. A home was moved out of the flood plain (MN River). Working on shoreland buffer setbacks. CD 1A ditch improvement in 2012/2013 working with DNR on Erin Lake outlet.
